Solitary neurofibroma is the most common of three types and occurs commonly in younger individuals regardless of sex. Various body parts have been reported to be affected by neurofibromas, including the abdominal wall. However, neurofibromas in the abdominal wall are rare, and recurrent cases have not been found in the literature. This study reported a case with multiple recurrent neurofibromas in the abdominal wall. This case is rare, and the manuscript is very interesting. Only some minor language polishing should be checked and corrected.
