The authors provide a detailed and through summary of intervention strategies implemented in Macau SAR, China that had potential COVID-19 outbreak contained successfully. Overall the quality of presentation is very good and I feel the experiences were extremely useful and informative. The exact measures and strategies may not be directly adapted in other regions facing new outbreak risk, I would suggest providing some comments on how these experiences could guide future effort in discussion. I have one minor comment on the figure 1 presentation, however. It's is not clear on how the total number of confirmed case changed overtime in the percentage plot. Could the authors modify the figure to show both the case number as well as the proportion of case origin at the same time?
