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The authors report a case of gastric plexiform fibromyxoma detected in an adult patient. The manuscript requires revision before publishing. The authors should try to point out peculiarities of the case. In case of few, a format of Images in // type could be a solution. Standard requirements should be fulfilled: page numbering. Long and complex sentences could be simplified (1 idea/1 sentence): "Histology showed the tumor cells //", "The case showed focal positivity //", "According to the results of pathology //", similar). The size of the tumor should be noted in the Abstract. Did the tumor show necrosis? Was the tumor detected at clinical examination? on imaging procedures? Examples of words/phrases to revise "of the stomach especially in the gastric antrum" "Our patient" the present case, the patient (1 case report, understood that the same patient) "plus" and? "SMA" smooth muscle actin? "The case showed focal positivity for S-100" the tumor can show positivity for S-100 protein "45-year-old male." male patient? "the density within the tumor was not uniform" heterogeneous density? avoid repetitive words in a same paragraph "the patient" Figures: indicators (arrows) could be added to the photographs.

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The authors report a case of gastric plexiform fibromyxoma with review of literature. I have my doubts about their strategy for the tumor. There is no mention of endoscopic findings and histological findings on preoperative biopsy. As you know, there are many kinds of gastric submucosal tumors, for example, GIST, leiomyoma, schwannoma, ectopic pancreas, hamartomatous inverted polyp, submucosal heterotopic gastric gland and some undifferentiated gastric cancers. The authors shall clearly state the reasons of preoperative diagnosis. The treatment strategies should differ depending on the preoperative diagnosis. Though plexiform fibromyxoma is rare, we can confirm a certain number of reports about gastric PFs. Unfortunately, it is difficult to find brand new knowledge about gastric PF in this report.

The R1 revised version of the manuscript shows improvement. However the manuscript



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cannot be published yet. Examples of parts to reformulate for the Abstract "Usually" rarely used for scientific documents, terms use "More frequently" "The patient was admitted to hospital, due to a 1-week history of an abdominal space-occupying lesion identified during a health examination.": after a 1-week history? after 1-week history of explorations? The authors should note the clinical complaints and their duration (if available). They should add precise informations of the diagnostic procedures: type of imaging procedure (CT scan, ultrasound examination, other). The size of the tumor should also be noted. A conclusion should be formulated. Other examples of words/phrases to revise "The boundaries of the tumor are unclear" "Here we describe one case //" report one case "An enhanced CT scan" CT scan with contrast substance injection? "To date, 121 cases have been reported" To date, to the knowledge of the authors/as searched on the following databases (journals, internet databases, other) "one year ago" one year previously "WHO adopted the opinion of Miettinen and others" avoid repetitive "occur/occurrence" "invades the submucosa and muscularis" "in the literature" medical literature? "and some of it is translucent" "appears to grow in multiple sections" avoid "It is" sentence "The authors believe that the positive expression of A-100 //" please reformulate and note reference number "leiomyoma cells have the characteristics of an eosinophilic cytoplasm //" leiomyoma cell have eosinophilic cytoplasm sentence "Surgeons must cooperate //" too general, please reformulate "Plexiform fibromyxoma has good biological behavior." too general, biological evolution? "and no cases have confirmed that malignant transformation will not occur" too general, please add reference number "longitudinal observation"
