However, i have minor comment regarding the procedure of EUS guided injection: 1. during active bleeding you can visualize varices clearly by EUS. however, how did you identify the bleeding varix by EUS? 2. the figures are nor clear whether it is the varix or the perforator vessels or paraesophageal collaterals? please attach clear figures including the injection procedure.
