SPECIFIC COMMENTS TO AUTHORS

It is a interesting case report and not usual after total knee arthroplasty. Usually the main complication after TKA is stiffness of the patellofemoral and not instabillity or dislocation. The main question for me is to make the readers understand why you decided to performed that new technique and not for example restotation of medial retinaculum with patella resurfasing. The other points for revision are minor. Very good work (discussion session).
