Overall, **small cell carcinoma of the rectum** appeared to be more likely to metastasize to the liver, pulmonary, lymph nodes and bone. Distinguishing features of **small cell carcinoma of the rectum** were noted as a thickening rectal wall, the presence of soft-tissue tumors, local **tumor** invasion, lymphadenopathy and distant metastases.
