SPECIFIC COMMENTS TO AUTHORS

This is a manuscript about a clinical case of pediatric liver transplantation with living donor in which the left lateral sectionectomy (L-LLS) liver graft has been obtained through a single-port laparoscopic approach. As this is the first case in the literature using this procedure, we believe that from a technical point of view it represents an important advance in liver transplantation. The authors reflect in the discussion that this approach has a better view of the surgical field than when practiced with multiple ports. It is evident that we must congratulate the authors for having developed a high degree of expertise in this surgery, with excellent results. My prudence in relation to this technique in my opinion is that its application is limited to surgeons who are very expert with the single port, and with liver surgery. On the other hand, in many cultures the priority of a small surgical wound is not relevant in the context of a living donor hepatectomy. In addition to the difficulties in performing single-port triangulation in liver surgery, we should also note that in the experience of single-port laparoscopic abdominal surgery one of the most important criticisms compared to multiple ports is the higher incidence of eventrations,
