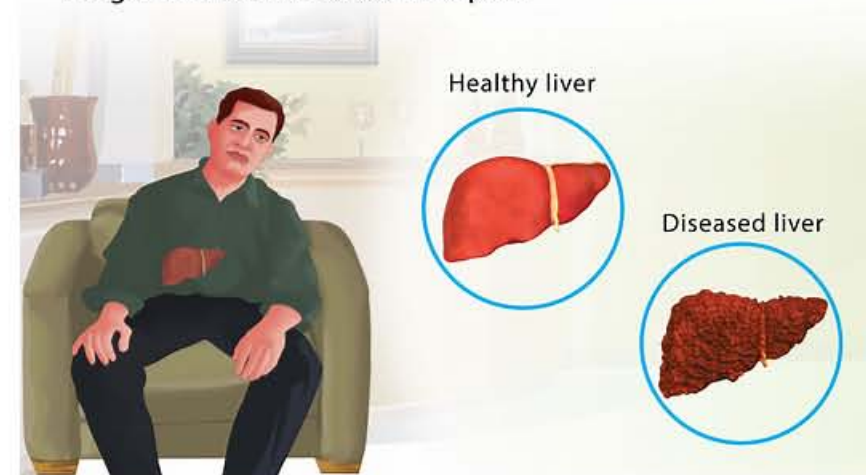

Nutritional status is an important factor that can influence the postoperative course in patients undergoing major cancer surgery. Medical Condition

Fatigue and severe abdominal pain



A degenerative disease of the liver resulting in scarring and liver failure.

Common (More than 200,000 cases per year in US)

Requires lab test or imaging

Treatments can help manage condition, no known cure

Can last several years or be lifelong

Alcohol abuse and Hepatitis B & C virus infections are the most common
