(1) Patient's age and gender have been added.

(2) Acute rejection and biliary cast have the similar clinical symptoms. Acute rejection after liver transplantation generally occurs 1 to 3 weeks postoperatively, but biliary cast generally form at least 1 month after transplantation surgery and there is less acute rejection at this period.

(3) 15 patients' biliary casts were investigated. All the patients were treated in our department for the similar clinical symptoms of jaundice, recurrent cholangitis and high fever.
