**Specific Comments to Authors:** I reviewed with a great interest the minireview by Saad Ur Rahman and colleagues about the paraneoplastic syndromes in cholangiocarcinoma (CCA). Various case reports have been reported focusing on single paraneoplastic syndromes in CCA. This review summarizes collectively different paraneoplastic syndromes which are associated with CCA to give a better idea about how it affects various organ systems. These syndromes can present as dermatological, neurological, renal, hematological or multi-systemic manifestations. Overall the manuscript is well written and well organized and provides an excellent overview of paraneoplastic syndromes in CCA. The title and the abstract well reflect the work described in the minireview. Minor point - Additional studies could have been included: Neurological Manifestations. Bruhnding and colleagues described a case of a man with anti-Yo positive paraneoplastic cerebellar degeneration in the setting of occult CCA (PMID: 27816258).
