- (1) Reviewer 00538725: "This is a nice informative systematic review on the topic. I suggest giving some words to comment on the current opinions on surgical management for MALT."

**REPLY:** The following sentence has been added in page 10, paragraph 2; "Surgical resection nowadays is restricted to the management for cases with perforation or bleeding that cannot be controlled endoscopically<sup>[26]</sup>."

- (2) Reviewer 00044945: "The authors developed a interesting review on the molecular basis of the role of *H. pylori* infection on gastric Malt as well as the results of *H. pylori* infection treatment on gastric Malt. In order to make the review more comprehensive, the authors could describe the staging categories (I, IE, II, etc.) as well as the main antibiotic regimens employed for *H. pylori* eradication in the setting of gastric Malt."

**REPLY:** 1) To explain the Lugano staging system, a new Table 1 has been made, which is cited in page 8, line 3. Accordingly, original Tables 1 and 2 should be new Tables 2 and 3, respectively.

2) Three sentences describing regimen for *H. pylori* eradication has been added in page 9, paragraph 2; "As for the regimen for *H. pylori* eradication therapy, ... after the second- line treatment or more attempts<sup>[36]</sup>." With this regard, two published articles have been newly referenced (35 Malfertheiner P, et al. Gut 2012; and 36 Zullo A, et al. Am J Gastroenterol 2009).
