1) Page, 12, Limits of the study: Please change "Limits" into "Limitation". Further, add the "Future prospectives" as last paragraph. I think it will be better. Do not described the Limitation of this study as the last paragraph.

-> I changed "limits" into **Limitations of this study. I realized that "conclusion" is needed in the last paragraph according to Journal's format and I added "conclusion" in the last paragraph. I also thought your suggestion was good and it could satisfy both your suggestion and the journal's format.**

2) I think the study design of this retrospective, one institution cohort study will not be changeable, however, the presentation of the result of the study is so nice and compactly summarized. Please add the new table(s) described the results on the similar manuscripts that have been published to date, and add the new references and the more discussions on the published manuscripts on prospective studies, if possible.

-> I added the **new tables as Table 1** described the results in the previous studies which demonstrated the value of CEA levels to predict the response of preoperative CRT for rectal cancer in the introduction. Although most of them were retrospectives, some were prospective designed studies I cited

Also I **updated references within recent 3 years** and more discussion about **published prospective studies in the discussion.**
