A splendid attempt by authors, in highlighting the co-occurrence of cancer with a benign adenomatoid tumour. They have drawn a right conclusion and the message of knowing this association is important in staging and management of patient after surgery. I would advise to look at a few grammatical errors and consider labelling the gross specimen, pointing the oviduct / uterine cavity (Figure 1)
