SPECIFIC COMMENTS TO AUTHORS

In the present case report Han et al described the case of a young woman with adult-onset Still disease who developed a fatal multi organ failure after an incision that did not heal. Main comments: 1) The conclusion of the Abstract does not support any relevant message. 2) Please avoid some phrases such as “the heart stopped”. 3) Several acronyms in the Abstract have not been explained (MAS, DIC). 4) Page 7: SF? 5) Do not use the commercial name of tocilizumab. 6) Please explain the total duration of corticosteroid therapy. Was it administered continuously for more than 20 years? 7) How can the Authors conclude for cytokine storm syndrome with certainty? The patient was under a strong immunosuppression (anti-IL6) and it does not seem that Authors have excluded cutaneous infection of the wound, osteomyelitis over osteonecrosis or an infection of the prosthesis; indeed, for example a skin culture or a myeloculture were not performed. Furthermore procalcitonin was very high, therefore the patient may have died for septic shock.
