Deep vein thrombosis occurs with a prevalence of 1:1000. It is seen less in younger population with an estimated incidence of 1:10000. Anomalies of IVC are an independent risk factor for DVT. DVT associated with left sided IVC usually affects young population. This case is 66 years. In general, IVC malformations (left sided IVC) are often DVT in younger population.
