This manuscript, 59350, describes and reviews the pertinent literature of a rare case of acute pancreatitis (AP) complicated with pulmonary embolism (PE). The report brings to the attention the importance of dynamically monitor blood coagulation indicators such as D-dimer during the diagnosis and treatment of AP, and to be alert to the occurrence of deep vein thrombosis and PE. The report provides well researched justification of the importance of venous thrombosis and lung function assessment in the management of AP. This is a well structured presentation.
