However, there are some minor mistakes that need to be corrected for instance: -Please check the grammar - for instance page 4/49 - Core tip section - first sentence - there is probably missing something (is?) in the first sentence: "Core tip: Whether tumor mutation burden (TMB) associated with favorable prognosis remained controversy in various cancers." -

Figure 8 : please include in the legend what bullet with the number (17-22miRNAs) denotes - Figure S1: there are 2 times $P < 0.001$ (* and .) but on the figure there are only * - was these error? -Table S1: colorectal cancer patients - please correct into gastric cancer patients
