SPECIFIC COMMENTS TO AUTHORS

Major criticism: -Vancomycin induced seizure was first described by Caglayan et al. in a 10-year-old girl in 1992. (Caglayan, S., Ozdogru, E., Aksit, S., Kansoy, S., & Senturk, H. (1992). Vancomycin-Induced Hypertension with Transient Blindness and Generalized Seizure. *Pediatrics International*, 34(1), 90-91.doi:10.1111/j.1442-200x.1992.tb00932.x)

Minor criticisms: -Case report section is unnecessarily long and should be shortened. -I would like to see information of the staging, especially to rule out brain metastasis. -CSF results (especially cytology and biochemistry), brain imaging results and EEG report are missing in case report section. -Normal ranges of CRP, vancomycin... should be indicated. -The dose and infusion time of vancomycin should be mentioned.
