For example: "In the 1960s, progressively earlier mobilization after the acute coronary event was practiced. It was realized that the belief that there would be measurable physical invalidism after an acute event was mostly unfounded[13]. this statment need clarification. There are some typos need to be fixed. Therefore, I suggest a good thorough proofreading of the manuscript as it still need some improvement.
