This statement needs to be discussed better. 2.It is necessary to discuss, among the causes of CIF, both those from impaired digestive capacity and those from impaired absorptive capacity. 3. CIF measurement systems, as well as clinical and laboratory parameters needed to diagnose CIF, must be explained and discussed. The study of steatorrhea and creatorrhea are necessary.
