Specific Comments to Authors: In this retrospective study, the authors analyzed the data of 10 patients surgically treated for gastrointestinal involvement of Behcet's disease (GIBD) and 106 patients surgically treated for Crohn's disease (CD) to identify notable clinical features and effective postoperative treatment for surgical patients with GIBD. It is a novel idea with obvious aim. The study is sufficient to reach the aim, written in a clear understandable language with logic conclusion. There are **few corrections** mentioned in the reviewed manuscript.
