Abstract

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We report a case of a 55-year old woman with a prior roux-en-Y gastric bypass who survived after surgical repair of a gastro-left ventricular **fistula**. Fistulization between the left ventricle and the stomach is a rare and usually fatal diagnosis.

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Jun 01, 2016 - Secondary aortoenteric **fistula** is a rare and dreaded complication of aortic graft replacement. This case demonstrates successful management of a patient with thoracic aortic graft infection resulting in aorto-esophageal **fistula** and the feasibility of combined endovascular approach as a temporary measure to stabilize the patient in extremis, followed by a definitive surgical repair.

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Endoscopic placement of covered, self-expanding stents provides instant occlusion of the **fistula** that allows immediate oral feeding. Inner sealing of the leak shortens the healing time of anastomotic and **esophagocutaneous fistula** to an average 6 days **after** stent implantation, as previously reported

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Nov 29, 2009 · Despite close anatomical relation ship between the trachea and the esophagus, a benign postoperative tracheo-**gastric fistula after** esophagectomy with **gastric pull-up** for cancer is a rare but life-threatening complication.
