This case report introduces a magnet-based way to eliminate Intralenticular foreign body in the anterior cortex. Generally speaking, the work of this report is complete and effective. However, there are some issues that need to be further improved: (1) The Abstract and Introduction are not comprehensive and need to be polished. Please add more appropriate citations and highlight the importance of your work. (2) More motivation/context regarding the application side of your treatment should be added, particularly on the aspects that make this technique particularly suited for clinical application scenarios. (3) The problems encountered in the process of treatment should be summarized and analysed in the Discussion, since these information are crucial for the readers. (4) Review the details of the entire text. For example, the explanation is needed when the abbreviation appears firstly in the report (e.g., the FB was pushed to the equator of the lens).
