I enjoyed reading this very well written and informative case report and discussion of the background pertinent to this case. Thank you. There are minor grammatical errors which are tracked in the attached reviewed document.

Science editor:

1 Scientific quality: The manuscript describes a case report of the bilateral posterior scleritis misdiagnosis as PACG. The topic is within the scope of the WJCC. (1) Classification: Grade B; (2) Summary of the Peer-Review Report: This article is well written and informative, and give a good overview of posterior scleritis. There are minor grammatical errors which are tracked in the attached reviewed document. The questions raised by the reviewers should be answered; and (3) Format: There are 7 figures. A total of 10 references are cited, including 5 references published in the last 3 years. There are no self-citations.

Answering: I performed the re-edit and made some changes with the help of “Filipodia editing service” . They have created an updated Certificate of Service for WJCC. I hope my paper's grammar and formatting were correct and perfectly adherent to the BPG detailed requirements.

2 Language evaluation: Classification: Grade A. A language editing certificate issued by Filipodia was provided.

3 Academic norms and rules: The authors provided the CARE Checklist, and informed consent. No academic misconduct was found in the Bing search.

4 Supplementary comments: This is an unsolicited manuscript. The topic has not previously been published in the WJCC. The corresponding author has not published articles in the BPG.

5 Issues raised: I found the authors did not provide the original figures. Please provide the original figure documents. Please prepare and arrange the figures using PowerPoint to ensure that all graphs or arrows or text portions can be reprocessed by the editor.
