Medical Condition

- A chronic inflammation of the digestive tract.
- Rare (Fewer than 200,000 cases per year in US)
 - Requires lab test or imaging
 - Treatments can help manage condition, no known cure
 - Can be lifelong

The exact cause is unknown but heredity and malfunctioning immune system play a role. Common symptoms include abdominal pain, diarrhea, malnutrition and fatigue. Anti-inflammatory drugs and immune system suppressors help in long term remission.

Symptoms

- Symptoms range from mild to severe and include:
- Abdominal pain and tenderness
 - Feeling of a filled abdomen
 - Tiredness
 - Diarrhea, which can be mixed with blood, mucus or pus in severe cases
 - Constipation
 - Nausea
 - Weight loss
 - Fever
 - Rectal bleeding
 - Inflammation of the joints, eyes, and mouth

Children with crohn's disease may report retarded growth or delayed sexual development.

Treatments

Treatment includes medications, nutritional supplements, and surgery, either independently or in combination. Treatment options depend on the location and severity of the disease.

Medication

- Anti-inflammatory drugs: To reduce inflammation.

Self care

- Fluid replacement to prevent dehydration.
- Nutritional supplements to replace lost nutrients, including iron, vitamin B, calcium and vitamin D supplements.

Medical procedures: Colectomy

Causes

- The exact cause of crohn's disease is not known. The following factors play a role:
- Family history
 - Ethnicity, for example, crohn's disease is commonly reported in Jews and Caucasians
 - Autoimmunity: where the immune system attacks the body's own cells
 - Environmental factors such as cigarette smoke or pollution

Medical Condition

A rare, long-term skin condition characterized by tiny, painful bumps under the skin.

 Very common (More than 3 million cases per year in US) Doesn't require lab test or imaging Treatments can help manage condition, no known cure Can last several years or be lifelong

It develops when the hair follicle is blocked, most commonly, near the sweat glands. Formation of bumps in a hairy region and also where the skin rubs such as the armpits, the groin, between the buttocks and under the breasts. These could be inflamed, painful, pus filled. Early diagnosis and treatment will help manage the condition and further development of new lumps.

Symptoms

- Develops on body areas where the skin rubs each other such as the armpits, groins, anus, inward of thighs
- Characterized by red, tender bumps
- Itching and swelling of the bumps
- Painful
- Bad odor when the pus leaks

Treatments

Treatment depends on the severity and involves medications and surgery.

Medication

- Antibiotics: Control inflammation and if any infection. Usually a combination of drugs are prescribed.
