The authors report the case of a 53 year old man who experienced a number of clinical signs and symptoms (dysphasia, localised kinetic tremor and mirror movement of the left arm) which appeared in the course of 18 months after an acute talamic haemorrhage. The authors further describe the clinical signs, the rarity of them appearing and especially grouped like this and offer a brief physiopathological explanation.
