Inflammatory Bowel Disease (IBD) is a broad term that describes conditions characterized by chronic inflammation of the gastrointestinal tract. The two most common inflammatory bowel diseases are ulcerative colitis and Crohn's disease. Inflammation affects the entire digestive tract in Crohn's disease and only the large intestine (also called the colon) in ulcerative colitis.



Medical Condition

A group of inflammatory conditions of the colon and small intestine



A group of intestinal disorders that cause inflammation of the digestive tract.

- 📊 Common (More than 200,000 cases per year in US)
- 🧪 Often requires lab test or imaging
- 🩹 Treatments can help manage condition, no known cure
- 🕒 Can be lifelong

IBD is said to be the result of autoimmune reactions. Inflammatory bowel disease (IBD) presents as Crohn's disease or ulcerative colitis. It may be characterized by diarrhea, abdominal pain and cramping, tiredness, and weight loss. Anti-inflammatory drugs play an important role in the treatment. Surgery is sometimes performed.

Symptoms

Symptoms may vary from mild to severe and include:

- Diarrhea
- Fever
- Fatigue
