1. Include the total number of patients in the study in the abstract.

We have included the total number of patients (11,728 patients) in the methods section of our abstract.

2. In the limitations mention that this study is unable to comment on long term outcomes.

We have acknowledged that this study is unable to draw meaningful conclusions about long-term patient outcomes, in the discussion section of our manuscript.

4. In the limitations mention that future prospective studies (potentially a RCT) would be better at reviewing short/mid/long term outcomes, patient reported outcomes and complications.

We have mentioned that future prospective studies are needed to review short/mid/long term outcomes, patient reported outcomes and complications, in the discussion section of our manuscript.
