This manuscript introduced a rare complication caused by a foreign body, and I really appreciate your work for reminding that foreign body can cause serious consequences. This paper introduces the causes of delayed pseudoaneurysm formation in detail, and remind us that it is very difficult to detect or identify a wooden material penetrating an area around the neck by using plain x-ray and conventional radiogram. Despite these merits, I still hope the authors can discuss more different complications of trauma caused by a foreign body, and if possible, the authors can introduce the role of surgical navigation technology for foreign body removal.
