Sorry for the delay and thank you for your invitation to review WJG-63616 - "Management of HBV infection in patients with inflammatory bowel disease under immunosuppressive treatment". The manuscript systematically described the management of HBV in patients with IBD", I am interested in reading it . I suggest to accept this manuscript if the autor could revise it. Minor points 1. Page 7, "HBeAg-" may be "HBeAg-negative"?; Page 11, I don't know the mean of "per se". 2. The content of "HBV REACTIVATION" were a little thin, the harm of HBV reactivation was not well described, for example, acute liver failure was not rare in HBV patients with immunosuppression once HBV reactivation happened. May the author could add some content about this.
