Infliximab has been shown to be efficacious in improving fistula closure rates in randomized controlled trials. Perianal Crohn's disease: a review

Crohn's Disease

Medical Condition



Severe abdominal pain and tenderness

A chronic inflammation of the digestive tract that leads to abdominal pain, severe diarrhea, fatigue, weight loss and malnutrition..

-  Rare (Fewer than 200,000 cases per year in US)
-  Requires lab test or imaging
-  Treatments can help manage condition, no known cure
-  Can be lifelong

The exact cause is unknown but heredity and malfunctioning immune system play a role. Common symptoms include abdominal pain, diarrhea, malnutrition and fatigue. Treatment includes medications, nutritional supplements, and surgery, either independently or in combination. Treatment options depend on the location and severity of the disease.

Symptoms

Symptoms range from mild to severe and include:

- Abdominal pain and tenderness
- Feeling of a filled abdomen
