## **SPECIFIC COMMENTS TO AUTHORS**

In this Opinion Review article the Authors address a key point in stem cell-related research and commerce: the use of stem cells and /or their related products in the cosmetic field. The article provides original points for discussion on an issue that is as widespread, as poorly analyzed for its medical implications, for possible misunderstandings, for the misleading messages provided to the consumer and for the high risk of fraud to the detriment of the consumer. There are several grammatical errors (i.e. single/plural, or not really appropriate words, such as "for the sacked of this article", page 2, line 7th from the top). Therefore, the article requires accurate checking of English words, and some rephrasing.
