I think authors add the reasons that they chose the USP15 for gastric cancer progression, proliferation, and invasion, in this study. The relationship between Wnt/ $\beta$ -catenin and USP15 is not clear.

**2. I think authors add the reasons that they chose the USP15 for gastric cancer progression, proliferation, and invasion, in this study.**

**Answer:** Thanks very much for your instructive comments. Increasing evidences showed that ubiquitin-specific proteases (USPs), the largest deubiquitinase subfamily, played an important role in gastric cancer. For example, USP14, USP42 and USP44 were up-regulated in gastric cancer, and could be used as independent prognostic markers in patients with gastric. USP15, as one of the most important members of the USPs, has been found to have some amplifications in many tumors. However, the function of USP15 in GC and its potential mechanism have not been identified. Bioinformatics databases (TIMER <https://cistrome.shinyapps.io/timer/>, UALCAN <http://ualcan.path.uab.edu/>, and Kaplan–Meier Plotter Database Analysis <http://kmplot.com/analysis/>), based on The Cancer Genome Atlas (TCGA) database, indicated that the mRNA levels of USP15 in GC tissues was higher than that in normal tissues and up-regulated of USP15 was related to poor prognosis in patients with GC. Therefore, we chose the USP15 for gastric cancer progression in this study. In response to your valuable comments, we have made appropriate revisions in the “Introduction” part section.

**3. The relationship between Wnt/ $\beta$ -catenin and USP15 is not clear.**

**Answer:** Thanks very much for your instructive comments. According to the result of RNA-sequencing analysis, immunofluorescence and rescue experiments, we found that USP15 can activate the Wnt/ $\beta$ -catenin to promote the progression of gastric cancer. We are so regret that we do not demonstrate USP15 and the relationship between Wnt/ $\beta$ -catenin. Nevertheless, we used a protein interaction bioinformatics website, GeneMANIA, predicting that USP15 can interact with some upstream proteins (CTNNB1, NUSAP1) of the Wnt/ $\beta$ -catenin pathway, and the specific molecular mechanism problems need to be resolved in our future research.
