Reviewer #1

The authors present an extensive review of drug induced liver injury during pregnancy. Previous case reports are displayed in a table, in a clear and objective manner. More information could be provided regarding the possible influence of pregnancy on the physiopathological mechanisms of drug induced liver injury.

Thank you for pointing out this lacuna. We have now included a paragraph on how physiological changes during pregnancy may predispose to drug toxicity.

Fourth paragraph under 'DILI IN PREGNANCY'

"Besides the above-mentioned factors, physiological changes that occur during pregnancy are also known... the actual clinical significance of these changes has not been adequately studied^[29]."

Since there are no adequate studies linking these changes to predisposition to hepatotoxicity, we have avoided presenting more detailed information on this aspect. We hope that the newly added information addresses the reviewers comment.
