Zhou et al. wrote this article about the thoughts on MDT therapy for left giant adrenocortical carcinoma. The manuscript reported a patient with a large left adrenal mass with a tumor thrombus in the left renal vein. The article is of high quality but few new ideas worth discussing have been put forward. However, the manuscript describes rare diseases and is of great significance to the treatment of ACC. Overall, the manuscript is well written, and the summarization of information is generally all-round. Although the quality of language should be improved, the topic is interesting with a high guiding significance. I would suggest to accept this manuscript with a minor revision.
