In this study, the authors investigated the effects of angiotensin receptor blockers and angiotensin converting enzyme inhibitors on COVID-19. Lung CT data and laboratory values of COVID-19 patients with hypertension were analyzed. The most severe CT images of the two groups and the laboratory examination results within two days of the corresponding CT images were compared. The authors found that chronic use of RAAS inhibitors is not related to the severity of COVID-19, and it does not worsen the clinical process.
