Major Comments- *A) Introduction* The introduction seems to be very weak. The focus should be on Ortho Perio interrelationship in aggressive periodontitis. The effects of pathological migration on occlusion harmony should be discussed in brief. The treatment sequence should be included in the need for study with proper reference (Other than case reports). *B) Chief complaint* The chief complaint must be in patients own words and not related to dentists observations. *C) History of present illness* HOPI must be the elaborate discussion about patients chief complaint and other major findings. *D) Personal history* Personal history includes Oral hygiene habits and presence/absence of habits like smoking and other parafunctional habits. *E) Physical examination* Radiographic interpretation is mentioned under physical examination. Clinical attachment levels and mucogingival findings should be mentioned which are of importance in Ortho Perio Cases. *F) Diagnosis and Treatment Plan* Diagnosis should also include 2017 World workshop classification system as Aggressive Periodontitis is discontinued. Kindly include phase wise treatment plan. *G) Treatment* Kindly mention in detail how Non surgical and surgical Periodontal therapy was performed. Kindly mention changes in Periodontal parameters after non surgical periodontal therapy and what was the re-evaluation period taken before starting Ortho treatment. What was the treatment for bone loss in upper and lower right quadrants?
