No schematic representation of PDPCs with microRNAs are present due to the lack of data in the scientific literature referred to this investigation field. **n. 02446104)** We believe that the expression “regenerative medicine” in the title, is more suitable than “osteocondral tissue repair” since the review also mentions allogenic transplantation and innovative applications besides bone and cartilage ones.

To point out more clearly the advantage of PDPCs in osteochondral tissue repair, we added the sentence “This is due to the fact that...” (P5, L3 of the paragraph “periosteum as cell source”).

The manuscript was integrated with two our own original paper results, too (ref. 84 and 88). Thanks for your advices.

**n. 2446158)** Manuscript was reorganized as indicated by the reviewer. All the suggested corrections were accepted. Title wasn't delete as requested because of reviewer's proposal is the running title.

The review offers an analysis of the hallmarks of PDPCs and talks out recent trends of regenerative medicine rested on periosteum. That requires an exhaustive dissertation.
