NIHP is a rare event, but the etiology is puzzling in many situations. The authors present two cases of NIHF with severe fetal anemia. The etiology was infectious in the first case and autoimmune in the second. Obstetric management was correct. The CARE checklist is incomplete. The authors should suggest a differential diagnosis of NIHF according to the immunologic conditions of the patients. Was COVID-19 excluded? Can COVID-19 be involved with NIHF? Please add it in the discussion.
