

Question: Please tell me did patients need additional treatment for these bared vessels after completed endoscopic necrosectomy.

Answer: Thank you very much for your question. According to our experience, no additional interventions were needed for these bared vessels. As for there were no active bleeding was found during we performed the secondary endoscopic necrosectomy. The key to avoiding bleeding is to keep the vessels intact. The following methods may be helpful to prevent bleeding during endoscopic necrosectomy. Firstly, we should always keep our eyes on whether there are vessels in endoscopic views, especially when we insert endoscopy or use rat-tooth forceps. Secondly, close monitoring of bleeding-related complications is very important during the patient's hospitalization. Finally, emergency surgeries could be performed by interventional radiologists in case of bleeding.
