Although this manuscript covers a broad range of gastrointestinal infections and carcinogenesis, it lacks the novelty that may help advance the research or management of gastrointestinal malignancy. It would be helpful if the authors could provide more in-depth and insightful discussions. In addition, the title does not reflect the main subject of the manuscript since there is no strong evidence to support that viral or bacterial infections cause some gastrointestinal cancers mentioned in the manuscript.
