Negative emotion can affect the hemodynamic fluctuation of patients undergoing interventional surgery, which is not conducive to the smooth and safe operation of interventional surgery. Programmed nursing formulates a series of nursing programs according to the characteristics of the interventional operating room. In addition, it intends to ensure the standardization, organization and rationality of nursing measures and to avoid the blindness and arbitrariness of nursing intervention. In this study, the authors explored the intervention effect of motivational psychological nursing combined with programmed nursing on compliance and bad mood of patients in interventional operating room. The study is very well designed, and the results are interesting. A minor editing is required. Some minor language polishing should be corrected.
