1 Scientific quality: The manuscript describes a retrospective study of the anthropometric method for estimating component sizes in total hip arthroplasty. The topic is within the scope of the WJO. The questions raised by the reviewers should be answered; (3) Format: There are 2 tables and 2 figures; (4) References: A total of 20 references are cited, including 2 references published in the last 3 years; (5) Self-cited references: There is no self-cited reference; and (6) References recommendations: The authors have the right to refuse to cite improper references recommended by the peer reviewer(s), especially references published by the peer reviewer(s) him/herself (themselves). Please provide the original figure documents. Please prepare and arrange the figures using PowerPoint to ensure that all graphs or arrows or text portions can be reprocessed by the editor; and (2) The "Article Highlights" section is missing. Please add the "Article Highlights" section at the end of the main text. 6 Re-Review: Not required. 7 Recommendation: Conditional acceptance.

Author response:
