This case report describes a patient with acute appendicitis complicated by mesenteric vein thrombosis (MVT) who recovered after conservative treatment. It describes the clinical course and the basis for diagnosis in detail, but I have the following concerns: In addition to the clinical course, referring to the past papers, it seems that acute appendicitis triggered MVT, but I think the mechanism needs to be further discussed. I think you need to refer to the following paper (Takehara K, et al. Superior mesenteric vein thrombosis as a complication of acute appendicitis: report of a case. Clin J Gastroenterol. 2013 Aug;6(4):269-73) and add Discussion along with the clinical data.
