1- Please mention the type of baby feeding in the patient introduction section(Was the newborn breastfed or formula fed?). 2-The initial presentation—in abdominal and lung X-rays—are incomprehensible. It is better to mention it separately and more precisely.(Bilaterally increased markings and mild flatulence were evident on the chest and abdominal X-ray) does not make any sense. 3-What was the result of the initial stool exam if requested? 4-Please mention in the discussion other cases of the CGD that have been reported in neonatal period so far and their clinical manifestations. 5- It should be discussed that diarrhea in this baby was a specific symptom of the CGD disease and not a finding of concomitant infection. 6-Was an abdominal or brain ultrasound requested for the baby?
