In my opinion only some minor changes must be performed to the main manuscript, in order to be further proceeded. 1) Please check the entire manuscript for language or grammar errors and revise it accordingly. 2) In the introduction section, the authors should give more information regarding the umbilical cord milking. Also, the authors are encouraged to give the pos and cons of the uc milking and placenta transfussion. In this way, the main topic of the manuscript can be more understandable for the readers. 3) In the section History of present illness, lines 106-128. Please clearly indicate the volume of the infused RBCs, FFP and platelets. 4) Please follow the author's guidelines and revise appropriately the references. 5) Also in Figure 1 and 2, please mark up each figure.
