However, if you mention in discussion: if there is any relation to procedure of thawing of frozen embryo and expected deep implantation into the myometrium?. This is because as mentioned in the paper, its incidence is high in such cases. You may add that Hegazy stated that in the natural implantation the trophoblast forms a cytotrophoblast shell to surround the gestational sac preventing further invasion into myometrium. Hegazy A.
