The review of the manuscript: Crohn's Disease-related 'Gastrocnemius Myalgia Syndrome' successfully treated with infliximab: case report and literature review The authors submitted the nice manuscript about a very atypical presentation of myositis restricted to the legs called the 'gastrocnemius myalgia syndrome' (GMS), an entity only described during Crohn's disease. Numbered comments: 1. Did you check for D-dimer, trombembolism would be my first DD idea? 2. The dose for CTS 0.8 mg per kg is unusual? 3. IFX is the therapy to induce and sustain remission, why did you combine therapies in the second attemp?
