(2) 00506325- Good work. One 16th page about wet to dry you put as best which is not right. we don't use it in UK. It may be cheapest but not best. Hydrocolloid is not suitable for plantar ulcers as the dressings move because of planter pressures and shearing, Grade C: a great deal of language polishing

Ans: Revised the manuscript in view of suggestion.

(3) 02446627- manuscript added as per the track changes and enclosed, Grade B: minor language polishing

Ans: Reviewer's suggestions were incorporated and necessary modifications have been done in the revised manuscript attached.

(4) 02446566 - This is a comprehensive review for handling diabetic foot ulcer. The effect of EGF may be overemphasized. According to a study in Cuba, local injection of 75 micro gram of EGF was needed (Fernandez-Montequin Int Wound J 6: 432). The style of the references is not as expected and should be corrected, Grade B: minor language polishing.
