The manuscript is well-written and results are interesting but I have some comments 1- I think that we have two factors to test diet and colitis (TNBS), thus the statistical analysis should be done using two-way ANOVA (Normal diet with or without TNBS and High fat diet with or without TNBS) and the figure presentation concerning the parameters measured in these groups should be changed. 2- The quality and size of the figures should be increased, as the figures are small and difficult to read, the author should consider the aspect ratio.
